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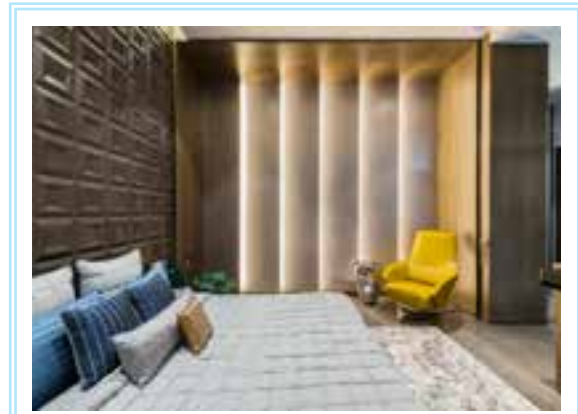

OVERVIEW

The 4BHK apartment project had a precise brief: the owners were a couple with two daughters who were in the fashion industry and one son who was in school. They wanted a modern, contemporary space, which would be easy to maintain, felt like a cozy home and yet had unique elements to make it stand apart.

The spatial program evolved after studying the lifestyles and habits of the couple and their children in detail. The intent was to create a design mark while optimizing the function of the space. The apartment only needed to be styled with furniture and embellishments, but the architects had a concept that worked on maximizing the view which needed them to demolish the current layout. Function and panoramic green view drove the design towards a comfortable decor with neutral colours featuring wood, veneer with natural polish and Italian marble. The living room opened onto the panoramic views of the city via the balcony while the dining space was an intimate space for family gatherings. The bedrooms were designed to reflect the personalities of those inhabiting the spaces. Overall the spatial language of the residence could be defined as elegant and minimal with quirky elements interspersed throughout the space.



The living room with mushroom leather seating and dining with highlights of rust leather on chairs, wallpaper and niches inset with soft lighting celebrates the length of 25 feet balcony facing the panoramic green Aarey greens.

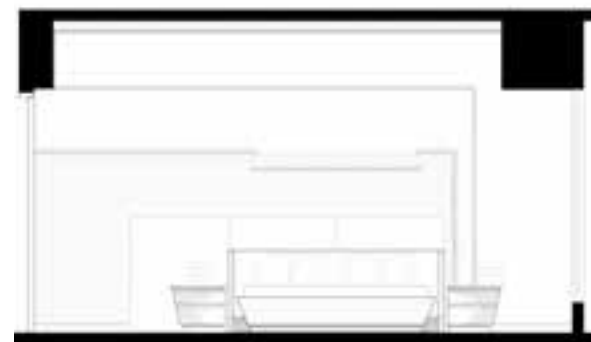
The dining corner in wood, leather, steel and linear light flow is the space where the family unites over meals and laughter.

The bold youthful spirit of the son's room is communicated through skewed lines embedded with strips of continuous LED lights. Folds of origami in the ceiling and skewed lines infuse the study corner in the son's bedroom with vibrancy, while the strategic installation of a large mirror attributes it with snug exclusivity.

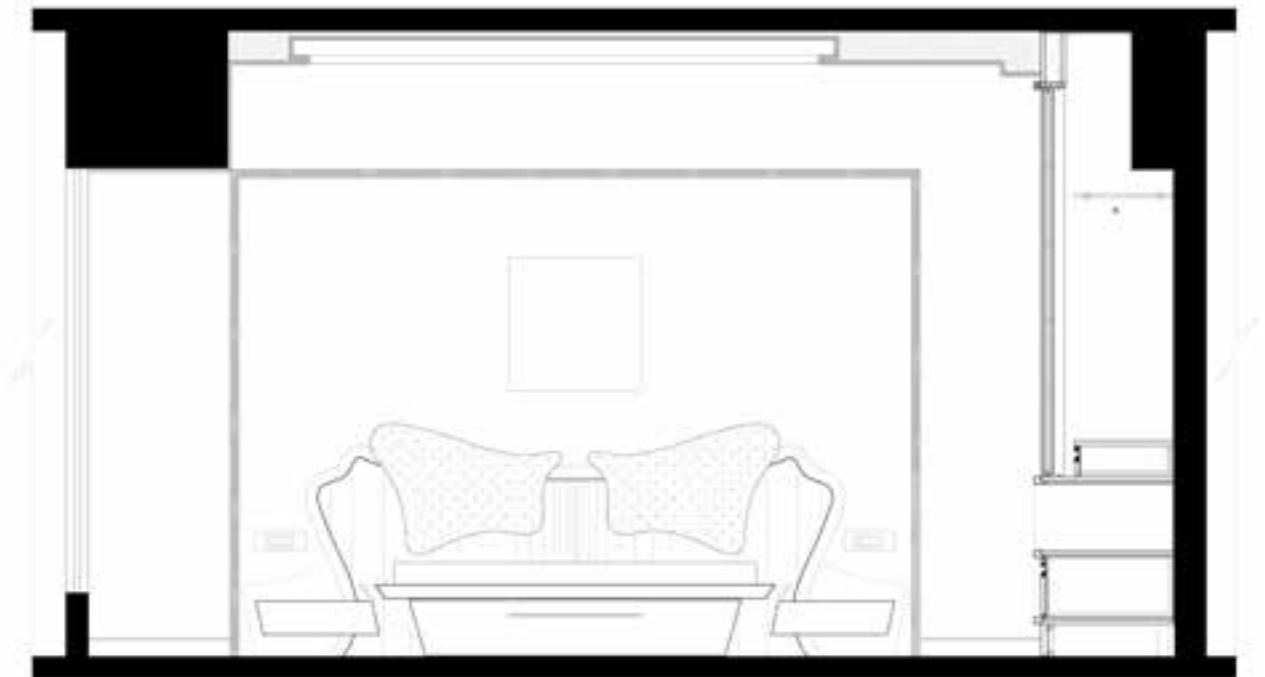

The space belonging to the younger sister was designed with demure pastels and a winged leather headboard to reflect the personality of a budding fashion designer and model.



BEDROOM DETAIL



The elder sister's room adorns a rustic charm with wood and metal. Copper sheet backdrop and Corbusier Dot series wallpaper from arte, complement the solid wooden side tables with copper base to highlight this elegance.



A leather writing desk, leather carpet, and a chair from Cecco add sleek grace, while the wardrobe with cracked wooden door, solid copper handles complements the design.



The exclusive dressing area was designed with detailing for storage, shoes, bags, accessories and a well-lit, stylish, full-length mirror for a walk-in vanity space.
